




SO LITTLE TIME TONIGHT!

- ➤ I will get back to you shortly!




EXPECTATIONS

- ➤ Will be writing across the curriculum




MATH

 - Online login gives you access to additional practice




READING

 - Work on Writing (journals & grammar)
- Guided reading groups
- ➤ Bilingual & English Language Learner support



WRITING

- Writing workshop format
 - ➤ Mini-lessons
 - ➤ Independent writing time
 - ➤ Teacher conferences
 - ➤ Share time
- ➤ Narrative, expository & argumentative writing
- ➤ Following the 5-paragraph structure
- Striving to include text-based evidence & details




SPELLING / VOCABULARY

- ➤ 10 words each week
- Six leveled words based on your child's needs
- ➤ Four words based on root word or prefix
- ➤ Tests on Fridays
- ➤ Mini-lessons in class
- ➤ At-home practice
 - Spelling square (challenge activity required)


SPELLING SQUARE

Pyramids Create a pyramid for each of your words. d da da day	Sentences Pick 6 words and write each of them in a third grade sentence. Remember that a third grade sentence is at least 8 words long.	ABC Order Write all your words down in alphabetical order.
Picture It Choose 6 words to illustrate. Draw a picture that represents the meaning of the word or draw something that reminds you of the word. Put a label next to each illustration.	Free Choice Create your own activity using all the words. Describe the activity below.	Mini Story Pick 6 of your words. Create a mini story using those words and underline each word when you use it. Make sure your story has a beginning, middle, and end.
Rainbow Words Write your words neatly. Trace over each word with at least 3 different colors.	<u>Vowels & Consonants</u> Write each word neatly. Write the consonants in blue and the vowels in red.	Cut It Out Search for letters in magazines and newspapers. Cut out the letters you need and glue them on paper to spell each of your spelling words. Make sure the letters aren't too tiny!





PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT


- ➤ Sign assignment notebook
- Respond to Friday letters & return to school on Monday
 - ➤ The more YOU write, the more YOUR CHILD will write!
 - ➤ Friday letters will be bound into a booklet at the end of the year for you to keep
- Assist with daily reading log
 - ➤ 20 minutes per night

WHY ARE THOSE 20 MINUTES SO IMPORTANT?

20 minutes per day = 3,600 minutes per school year


That's exposure to 1,800,000 words!

If your child maintains this routine, by the end of 6th grade, he or she will have read the equivalent of 60 whole school days!




